## Strike Action Ravenswood School Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2023.

Dear Parents/ Carers

As I am sure you are aware the National Education Union (NEU) is planning strike action on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April. The school has been busy completing our risk assessment. We are trying to ensure that as many classes as possible remain open and your child's education is not significantly disrupted. While we can plan for our school, the difficulty we are having is not knowing if support staff or teachers will be required to be home to care for their own children on strike days.

The current situation.

Below I have listed the classes that will currently remain fully open and classes that will remain open but will have a change of timetable on this day. Some open classes will have a change to their usual staff team.

If your child's class is **not listed** then this class will be **closed for the day and your child should not attend school.**

### **Fully Open; pupils expected in school.**

Duck, Owl, Robin, Hawk, Ash, Elm, Axe, P16 IO & P16 RM

### **Fully open but changes to timetable and staffing. Pupils are expected in school.**

Kingfisher, Bluebird, Yeo, Frome & P16 CW

I am sorry that we have not been able to keep all classes open. Our school staffing risk assessment has identified that this would not be safe.

I wanted to ensure that affected families have as much time as possible to make alternative arrangements for the day.

As we are dealing with a very changing situation this may need updating, I have asked school staff to let me know as soon as they are aware if they are unable to attend school. If we need to make any further changes / closures, we will notify you as soon as we can.
