### ABSENCE PROCEDURES

- Always inform school at the earliest opportunity.
- Medical and dental appointments require copies of appointments to be sent in
- Holidays or planned absences require a holiday form to be completed and returned to school
- Absence on the day You need to call in to school We need to know why they are off school and a planned return
- Without the above the absence may be marked as unauthorised
- High temperatures require the child to be 24 hours clear of the temperature without the need for medication before a return to school
- Sickness and diarrhoea require the child be 48 hours clear from the last bout before a return to

### FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Please check if your child is entitled to Free School Meals (FSM). These entitle your child to more than just a free meal. Please consider doing this, even if your child if your child is receiving Universal Free School Meals.

The FSM entitlement criteria are as follows:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of pension
   Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
