






How to

TREAT HEAD LICE







Apply lots of conditioner.

Use a comb and brush your child's hair.





Use a head lice comb and comb your child's hair in sections.

After each comb through the hair wipe the comb on a tissue.



- Repeat 4 to 5 times on each section of your child's hair.
- After you have finished, you can rinse out the conditioner.
 - You need to repeat the process everyday for a week.
- You need to check your child's hair twice a week for head lice.
