SWIFT KITCHEN

As you are aware School Age Pupils are now using Swift Kitchen to order meals, thank you for your support while we have embedded this new system. On the whole this has gone well but we would like to remind families the following:



School Age Children (Main Kitchen)

1. Please can all families including (FSM) order your child's meal in advance (you have until midnight the night before). If you have forgotten to do this your child will receive the main meal choice of the day.
2. Please ensure you have the funds in your account to pay for the meal. If you don't have the funds in your account to pay for the meal, please send your child in with a packed lunch.
3. If you don't have funds in your account and you have not provided a packed lunch, school reception will call home and give you the opportunity to provide something for your child or school will provide your child with a warm alternative.

Post 16 Pupils (Iles Kitchen)

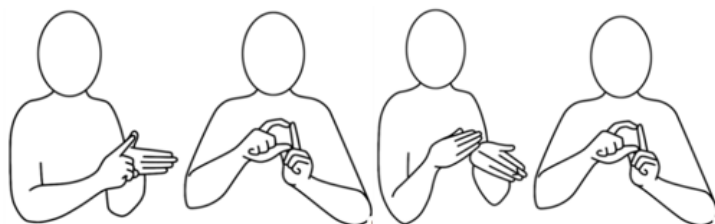
1. Please continue to use parent pay.

We have enjoyed making class lists and shopping lists in English too!



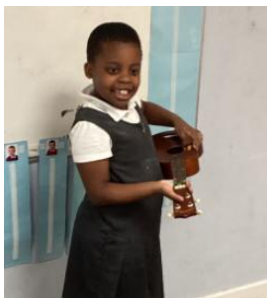


KINGFISHER CLASS NEWS

This term in Kingfisher Class our main topic has been 'All about me'! We have had a wonderful time getting to know each other and making lovely friendships! We had fun role playing and dressing up exploring different careers we would like to do in the future. In Art, we discovered the outline of our bodies drawing them on the floor with chalk, we decorated Kingfisher birds with a collage of our favourite things from a catalogue magazine of toys, and we developed our drawing skills using mirrors, completing mirrored portraits and drawing directly onto our reflections, learning to name the different parts on our faces.
