


PARENT CONSULTATION WEEK

We're inviting parents of pupils in years 8-10 to take part in a short questionnaire to share your views on your child's careers education and how well you feel they are being prepared for their future.



SWIFT KITCHEN

As you are aware School Age Pupils are now using Swift Kitchen to order meals, thank you for your support while we have embedded this new system. On the whole this has gone well but we would like to remind families the following:



School Age Children (Main Kitchen)

- 1. Please can all families including (FSM) order your child's meal in advance (you have until midnight the night before). If you have forgotten to do this your child will receive the main meal choice of the day.
- 2. Please ensure you have the funds in your account to pay for the meal. If you don't have the funds in your account to pay for the meal, please send your child in with a packed lunch.
- 3. If you don't have funds in your account and you have not provided a packed lunch, school reception will call home and give you the opportunity to provide something for your child or school will provide your child with a warm alternative.

Post 16 Pupils (Iles Kitchen)

- 1. Please continue to use parent pay.
- 2. If you have insufficient funds in your account, please provide your child with a packed lunch.
- 3. If you have insufficient funds to pay for the meal and you have not provided a packed lunch, the school reception will call home and give you the opportunity to provide something for your child or school will provide your child with a warm alternative.
- 4. Please note on non-college days, dinners will need to be ordered via Swift Kitchen, as above.

Please note the school cannot offer credit to any families.

Please can everyone remember to order and pay for your child's lunch through swift kitchen before returning to school. If your child is in P16 please ensure you have put money into your ParentPay account.

AEROSOLS
