Second Dose Covid-19:

Second dose Covid-19 vaccinations are now available for 12 to 15 year olds in Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire. You can book an appointment at a dedicated GP clinic or Vaccination Centre clinic using the online [National Booking Service](#) or by calling 119. They currently have lots of availability.

Your child is eligible for their second dose 3 months (90 days) after their first dose. If they catch Covid-19 after their first vaccination, they must wait 3 months after their positive test before having their second dose of the vaccine. For more information, please visit www.grabajab.net.

Covid Guidance

- Face coverings advised to be worn in all cooperate areas and on buses.
- All secondary aged pupils should do twice weekly LFTs at home (school can support if needed)
- If anyone's LFT is positive (however faint the line is) they must isolate immediately they do not need to do a PCR.
- If anyone shows signs of Covid 19 symptoms (Lack of taste or smell, cough or a high temperature), they must isolate immediately and get a PCR within 2 days (or isolate for 10 days)
- Close contacts of Covid cases (Or in the household) should do daily LFTs for 10 days from the contact. (Unvaccinated adults must self-isolate for 10 days)
- People with Covid 19 must isolate for 10 days. They can use LFT tests to be released early, but we recommend students who cannot wear a mask, stay at home until 10 days has passed, to protect our vulnerable students. If using LFTs to release, school must see proof of the two LFTs taken 24 hours apart BEFORE they can return to school, and they must be able to safely wear a face mask all day in school.
