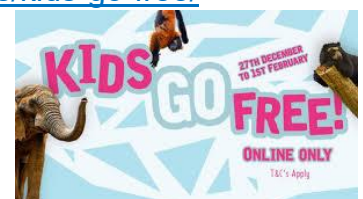


KIDS GO FREE AT NOAH'S ARK
