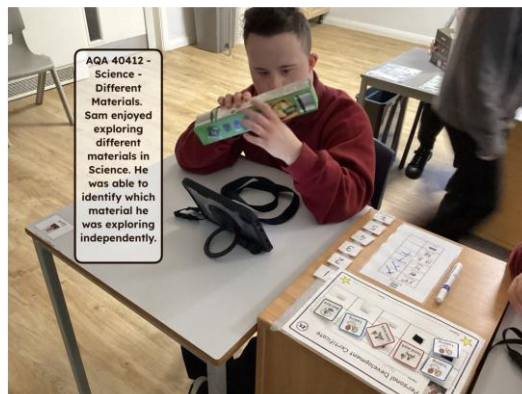
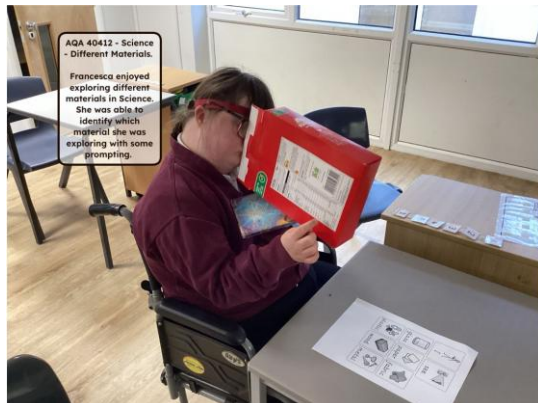




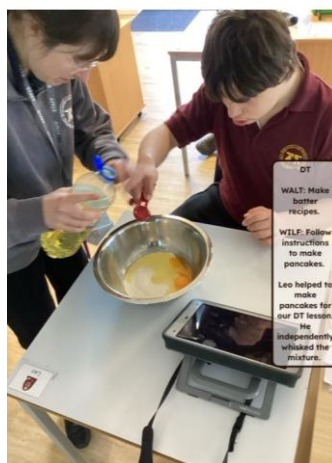


## YEO CLASS NEWSLETTER
