Covid testing

All secondary pupils are requested to continue with LFT regular Covid testing for asymptomatic cases. These LFT kits have been sent home so that you have enough for the next week or two. If any pupil tests positive on these please can you email info@ravenswoodonline.org.uk to inform the school so that we can inform any close contacts if they need to self isolate.

If your son/ daughter develops any Covid symptoms (new continuous cough, high temperature or loss/ change of taste or smell) please inform us asap via phone call or to the main school email above. This will help us to ensure that our school community is kept safe during this difficult time.

Parents/ carers can also request LFT tests for themselves via the Gov.uk website.

Sickness and diarrhoea

We have had a few recent cases of sickness and diarrhoea across the school. Please can we remind parents/ carers to practise safe hand washing at home and if your son/ daughter shows any signs to keep them at home for 48hours following the final bout. This will help to reduce the risk of transmission.

We have discussed these cases with Public Health and they have advised that these cases are highly unlikely to be linked to Covid-19.

Exams

Could parents of Year 11 and Year 13 pupils note that exams season is 17th May to the 18th June (with a 1 week break for Half term). Please do everything you can to ensure the pupils are in school during this time, so they don't miss out on their assessments. Functional Skills and Entry level exams are still going ahead and there will be G.C.S.E non-exam assessments for relevant pupils.
