All posts to this page have been reported to North Somerset Safeguarding Team and the Police. The Police investigation into the culprits is ongoing. The school has taken legal advice and will be guided by the Police once their investigation has concluded. The school has contacted Facebook and asked for this page to be removed.

We are aware that some of our current pupils have now seen the fake page. If you child has seen this page and wants to discuss this with you, please let them know that, the school are aware, the Police are aware and for them to block or delete the page.

If you are unaware of the page or your child has not seen it, please do not search for it, doing so will create more algorithms for the page which could result in more hurtful posts by these individuals.

Can I finally thank those parents who have also reported their concerns, I am confident that this will all be resolved shortly.

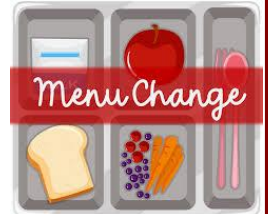

## REMINDER

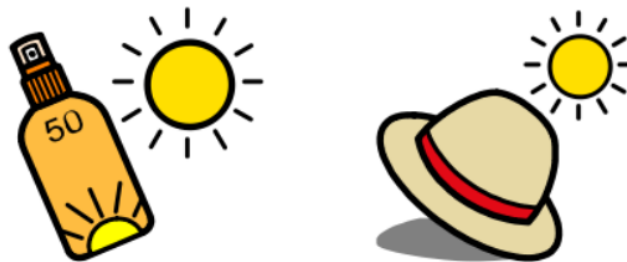
