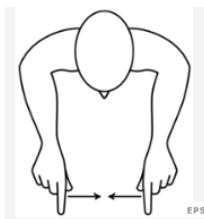

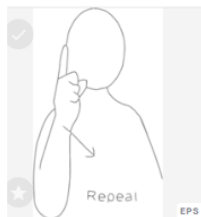

MAY 2026 UPDATE:

ACCEPTABLE MOBILE PHONE AND INTERNET USAGE

We are sometimes made aware of incidents involving inappropriate behaviour and conduct on mobile phones whilst pupils are at home. Whilst each incident is investigated at school, please can we remind all parents and carers to discuss with their child the acceptable usage of mobile phones, the internet and social media.

It is important to remind children that certain types of conduct, bullying or harassment can be classified as criminal conduct. The school takes such conduct extremely seriously and will involve the police or other agencies as appropriate. Such conduct includes, but is not limited to, sexting, threats of violence or assault, abusive calls, emails, social media posts or texts directed at someone based on their ethnicity, religious beliefs or sexual orientation.

If a pupil breaks the school's ICT Acceptable Usage Policy, we may remove their access to technology. If pupils continue to demonstrate inappropriate behaviour online at home, we will recommend that parents/carers do the same.

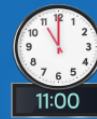
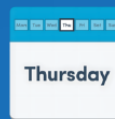
