GATES

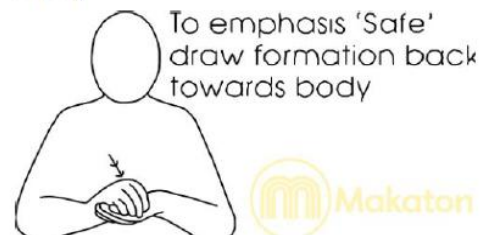
Just a quick reminder to all families, please ensure the entrance gates are fully closed behind you when entering and leaving school site. Thank you for helping keep everyone safe.

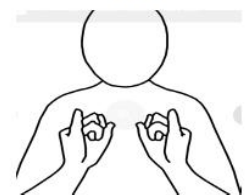

HEAD LICE

We have had few cases of head lice reported in school. Please could you check your child's hair regularly and treat if necessary.

If you are unsure how to treat head lice, please follow the guide below. Thank you for your support in helping us prevent further spread.

How to

TREAT HEAD LICE



1 Wash your child's hair.



2 Apply lots of conditioner.

3 Use a comb and brush your child's hair.



4 Use a head lice comb and comb your child's hair in sections.

5 After each comb through the hair wipe the comb on a tissue.



6 Repeat 4 to 5 times on each section of your child's hair.

7 After you have finished, you can rinse out the conditioner.

8 You need to repeat the process everyday for a week.

9 You need to check your child's hair twice a week for head lice.
