

## Ravenswood School - Covid restriction stages

<p>Stage 1- no restrictions-</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Classes can mix freely</li> <li>• No mask wearing required</li> <li>• Assemblies allowed</li> <li>• Whole school staff meeting resume</li> <li>• Regular hand washing</li> </ul>
<p>Stage 2- minimal restrictions-</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Department bubbles- can mix with one other class per day if recorded (or part of timetabled lessons)</li> <li>• Department assemblies allowed- whole school via TEAMS</li> <li>• Staff meetings allowed- max 30 people in one area</li> <li>• Whole school meetings via TEAMS</li> <li>• No mask wearing required</li> <li>• Regular hand washing</li> </ul>
<p>Stage 3- increased restrictions</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Department bubbles- no mixing outside of department unless part of timetabled lesson or agreed by SLT</li> <li>• No assemblies – move to TEAMS meetings</li> <li>• Teachers meeting in the hall- socially distanced</li> <li>• Class meetings allowed,</li> <li>• Department meetings in hall- max 30 people/ classroom- max 15 people/ outside- no limits</li> <li>• Whole school meetings via TEAMS</li> <li>• Masks in corporate areas</li> <li>• Ventilation in classes- at least one window open in classrooms/ mixed use areas.</li> <li>• Regular hand washing</li> <li>• Increased cleaning of touchpoints and toilets</li> <li>• Classes where there has been a confirmed Covid case to move to class bubble and no mixing outside of class except play and lunchtime.</li> <li>• If 3+ cases in one class the class will be isolated from all other classes (including play and lunch) until all PCR results have been returned negative.</li> </ul>
<p>Stage 4- High restrictions</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Class bubbles (unless part of timetabled lessons) – except outside playtime and lunch in hall</li> <li>• No assemblies- move to TEAMS meetings</li> <li>• All staff meetings via TEAMS</li> <li>• Physical meetings max of 8 people (unless class bubble)</li> <li>• Restrictions on number of people in a room</li> <li>• Masks in corporate areas</li> <li>• Regular hand washing</li> <li>• Increased cleaning of touchpoints and toilets</li> <li>• Ventilation in classes- at least one window open in classrooms/ mixed use areas.</li> <li>• If 3+ cases in one class the class will be isolated from all other classes (including play and lunch) until all PCR results have been returned negative.</li> </ul>
<p>Stage 5 – Omicon case in school- highest restrictions</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Close contacts with Omicon variant (or other variant deemed an increased risk)- class bubble and close contacts to move to remote learning. – using seesaw, email, physical work packs.</li> <li>• FSM pupils to have food packs delivered.</li> <li>• Rest of school moves to stage 4.</li> </ul>
<p>Stage 6- National lockdown</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Classes to move to remote learning- using seesaw, email, physical work packs.</li> <li>• FSM pupils to have food packs delivered.</li> <li>• Most vulnerable/ key worker children attend school</li> <li>• Staff to form Team A and Team B to support those at home/ in school</li> </ul>
